Certification given upon successful completion is valid for three years.

The telehandler or likewise known as a telescopic handler is similar in numerous ways to a crane and a common forklift. This versatile machine is constructed with a telescopic boom which can lift upwards and extend forward. A variety of attachments could be fitted on the end of the boom, like bucket, pallet forks, muck grab or lift table. It is popular in agriculture and industry settings.

The telehandler is a common used with fork attachments to enable the shuttling of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places that can't be reached by a standard forklift. Telehandlers can remove palletized loads from within a trailer and placing them on places which are high like rooftops. For certain applications, they could be more efficient and practical compared to a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its unsteadiness when lifting loads which are heavier. As the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes increasingly unstable. Counterweights in the rear help, but do not solve the problem. The lifting capacity rapidly decreases when the working radius increases. Various equipment come along with front outriggers that extend the lifting capacity while the machine is stationary.
